
Her parents rushed her to the emergency room where doctors performed a CT scan and delivered the devastating news that their beautiful daughter had a brain tumor. Amanda had surgery at the local hospital to remove the tumor and was taken to St. Jude Children's Research Hospital by ambulance.

At St. Jude, our doctors treated Amanda with eight weeks of radiation, and soon she was cancer free and able to return home. Then, in 2007, Amanda began experiencing chest pain and difficulty breathing. Doctors performed a CT scan and delivered heartbreaking news to Amanda and her family -- they believed the cancer was back, but this time it was in her lungs. So Amanda returned to St. Jude where our doctors confirmed that the cancer had indeed returned.

Following surgery to remove the lower and middle lobes of her right lung, Amanda had four more rounds of chemo and six weeks of radiation. I am thrilled to tell you that Amanda has responded well to treatment and she was able to participate in one of the most important milestones of her life -- walking with her graduating class in May 2007.

Amanda's family feels grateful for the compassion and generosity of friends like you, and Amanda is hopeful that her story will inspire others to support St. Jude so we can continue to make special moments like hers possible. Thank you.
